Circular Journey tickets:

- Indian Railway have provided the facility of Circular Journey Tickets for Passenger who want to go on pilgrimages or sightseeing trips.
- These tickets are issued for all journey, other than regular routes, which begin and end at the same station.
- A maximum of 8 break journeys are allowed on these tickets.
- The endorsement of break journey is not required on Circular Journey Ticket.
- Circular journey tickets are issued at a fare considerably lower than the regular point-on-point fare, calculated on Mail/Express fares.
- The validity period of the circular journey ticket will be calculated based on the distance for which the ticket is prepared.
- The ticket will be valid from the date of commencement of journey indicated on the ticket. The journey should be completed with the validity period of the ticket.
- If tickets are issued to passengers by other than normal and reasonably direct routes which is longer than 15% of the shortest route, than on such distances the telescopic benefit would not be applicable and normal fare would be applicable from point to point between that particular two break journey.
- Standard circular journey tickets are offered by Zonal Railways. The details of route fare for these tickets can be obtained from Divisional Offices.
- If the standard routes do not suit the needs of the passengers they can approach the Divisional Office to obtain circular journey tickets according to their itinerary.
