Day 1: Swachhata Pledges

On the first day of Swachhata Pakhwada 2024, various Swachhata Pledges and awareness activities were organized across multiple stations and railway offices under the Vadodara Division. The day emphasized mass participation and creating awareness about cleanliness and hygiene.

Swachhata Pledges:

• At the DRM Office, Vadodara (BRC), the Swachhata Pledge was led by DRM/BRC with participation from officers and staff.

Additionally, Swachhata Pledges were held at various railway offices and facilities:

• Electric Loco Shed BRCY, CCC-PRTN, led by CDO/PRTN, Diesel Shed BRCY, led by SSE/DSL-BRCY, Medical Units at Bharuch, Dabhoi, and CHI BRCY, ANND Railway Colony and PRTN Colony.

Day 2 - Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti & Swachh Bharat Diwas

On October 2nd, various activities were organized across the Vadodara Division to celebrate Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti and Swachh Bharat Diwas, promoting cleanliness and environmental awareness.

- Walk for Environment: A walk from Vidya Mandir (PRTN) to Heritage Park (PRTN) saw the participation of 250 employees, led by DRM/BRC.
- Shraddha Suman: Tribute to Mahatma Gandhi at Heritage Park.
- Plantation Drive: 80 plants were planted at Heritage Park (PRTN).
- Skit on Plastic Waste: A skit was performed to raise awareness about plastic pollution.
- Quiz Competition: Based on Swachhata, with prizes for correct answers.
- **Recognition of Cleaning Staff**: 12 dedicated contract and railway cleaning staff were felicitated with shawls and shields for their efforts in challenging conditions.
- Selfie Booth: A booth was set up for participants to take selfies promoting the campaign.
- Plant Distribution: 30 plants were distributed to BOS and staff.



Activities at Stations:

- Ankleshwar Station: A mass Shramdaan involving 20 railway staff and contract workers.
- **Bharuch Station**: Health camp was organized in which more then 100 patients were checked, and also Nukkad Natak was performed.
- Vadodara Station: A Shramdaan with 48 participants collected 21 plastic bags of garbage.
- **Bio-Toilet Exhibition**: Held at BRCP Station to promote sanitation at trains.
- Combined Shramdaan: Conducted at ANND railway station with Rotary Club, and similar drives were held at Nadiad, Godhra, and CCC-PRTN in that 165 participants were participated.



Day 3: Swachh Stations (Clean Stations)

On Day 3 of Swachhata Pakhwada, an intensive cleaning drive was conducted at major railway stations across the Vadodara Division, including Vadodara, Ankleshwar, Bharuch, Anand, Nadiad, Godhra, and Ektanagar Railway Stations. The efforts aimed at improving station cleanliness and hygiene.

Station Cleaning Highlights:

- Vadodara Railway Station: Intensive cleaning was carried out in waiting areas, platforms, and other public spaces.
- Ankleshwar, Anand, Nadiad, Bharuch, Godhra, and Ektanagar Stations: Similar cleaning efforts were undertaken, improving overall cleanliness and public amenities.

Railway Colony Cleanliness:

- **Anand Colony**: Swachh Neer drive focused on cleaning drains, toilets, and ensuring dustbins were properly utilized.
- Godhra Colony: A mass cleaning drive was held to enhance hygiene in the residential areas.





DAY- 4 Swachh Stations (Clean Stations) (other than major stations)

- During the Swachhta Pakhwada campaign on Days 3 and 4, an intensive cleanliness
 drive was conducted across 15 major and minor railway stations. The primary focus was
 on ensuring a high standard of cleanliness throughout all railway premises.
- Total of 63 cleaning machines, tools, and protective gear were made available and were confirmed to be in proper working condition to support the efforts.
- Total 1,371 dustbins were inspected to verify their availability and cleanliness, ensuring that proper waste management practices were followed at the stations.
- The cleanliness drive also covered critical areas such as drains, toilets, approach roads, Foot over Bridges (FOB), passenger waiting halls, and other railway premises, with 132 specific inspections were carried out.

Day 7: Swachh Patri (Clean Tracks)


Track Cleaning Highlights:

Day 8 Summary: Swachh Parisar Activities

Swachh Parisar Activities Highlights:

- Vadodara Railway Station: The waiting room, VIP room, and drains were cleaned, enhancing passenger comfort.



As part of Swachh Neer Day during Swachhata Pakhwada, an intensive water booth cleaning drive was conducted across multiple stations in Vadodara Division. Water points at Vadodara, Ankleshwar, Bharuch, Anand, and Nadiad stations were thoroughly cleaned.

Key activities included:

• Water Quality Checks:

- o Residual chlorine levels were tested at various locations, showing 0.2 ppm and 0.5 ppm.
- o Total dissolved solids (TDS) were measured at 770 ppm.
- o Three bacteriological water samples were collected to ensure safety.

Vadodara Yard:

- A water supply line leakage was identified and reported for immediate action.
- The area around a cooler in the Health Unit at Vadodara Yard was cleared of scrap items following inspections.








Medical Department:
