The criteria required for registration of the hospital are as follows:

1. The health care organisation must have been in operation for atleast one year. Copy of audited balance sheet, profit and loss account for the last financial year (Main document only- Summery sheet) is to be attached.
2. The HCOs must have the capacity to submit all claims / bills in electronic format to the Bill Clearing Agency and must also have dedicated equipments, software, and connectivity for such electronic submission.
3. Copy of NABH accreditation in case of NABH accredited health care organisation.
4. List of treatment procedures / investigations/ facilities available in the applicant health care organisation.
5. State registration certificate / registration with local bodies, wherever applicable.
6. Compliance with statutory requirement including that of waste management.
7. Registration under PNDT Act., if Ultrasonography facility is available.
8. AERB approval for imaging facilities / radiotherapy, wherever applicable.
9. Certificate registration for organ transplant facilities, wherever applicable.
10. An applicant health care organisation must have the capacity to submit all claims / bills in electronic format to the bill clearing agency and must also have dedicated equipment, software and connectivity for such electronic submission.

11. procedures / investigation / facilities available with them and as charged by them.
12. An applicant health care organisation must give the undertaking accepting the terms and conditions spelt out in the Memorandum of Agreement, which should be read as part of this application document.
13. Applicant Health Care Organisation must certify that they shall charge as per CGHS rates / Hospital rates whichever is lower and that the rates charged by them are not higher than the rates being charged from their patients who are not CGHS beneficiaries.
14. Applicant Health care organisation must certify that they are fulfilling all special conditions that they have imposed by any authority in lieu of social concessions such as but not limited to concessional allotment of land or customs duty exemption.
15. Applicant Health Care Organisation must agree for implementation of EMR / HER as per the standards notified by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare within one year of their empanelment.
16. Applicant hospitals, Cancer hospitals/Units must have minimal Annual Turnover of Rs. 2 crore for metro cities and Rs. 1 crore for non-metro cities. Further the business from CGHS in the latest financial year should not exceed more than 50% of the total business. A certificate to the effect from chartered accountant is to be given by the applicant health care organisation.

18. Name and address of the bankers.
