

Additional conditions**TERMS FOR OPERATIONS FOR TIE UP****Terms and Conditions:**

1. Should provide medical care in identified specialities (annexure –A) round the clock (24 x 7).
2. Provision of early registration, examination and admission of Railway patients referred by Jagjivan Ram Hospital, Mumbai Central, Mumbai.
3. For emergency cases, admission is to be done immediately.
4. Adequate medical attention is to be provided for serious patients.
5. The Hospital(s) recognised should display prominently in the website, notice board etc. indicating the specialities for which they recognised for tie up.
6. The railway beneficiaries will be referred to a particular empanelled hospital of his/her preference/choice.
7. The rates to be charged by the hospital should be as per the prevailing CGHS/ECHS/ESIC rates, if it is not available, either AIMS rates / any Government rates/ Autonomous Institutes rates or the hospital tariff, whichever is lower and for those items/ procedures/investigations which are not covered under CGHS rate list, the hospital should offer some discount or the same on their hospital rates as also free ambulance services to the railways.
8. The tie-up arrangement will be for a period of one year.
9. It is accepted to treat the _____ Hospital, as an empanelled hospital to provide medical advice and treatment including investigations, drugs, surgeries etc. to the Railway employees and their dependent family members in view of the better facilities and conveniences provided in the said hospital.
10. The railway employees and their family members referred to _____ Hospital are eligible for being admitted to the category of bed as mentioned in the authorisation letter of Medical Director, J. R. Hospital, Mumbai Central to _____ Hospital.
11. Patients will be referred to the empanelled hospital with a referral letter.
12. Patients should submit the medical health book, identity card or his departmental identity card at the time of admission containing the patient's photograph, signature/LTI.
13. The bill should be conform to the rate structure mutually agreed.
14. The empanelled hospital must send bills in duplicate to Medical Director, J. R. Hospital . The bills should be submitted for arranging payment once in a month.
15. Payment of the bills shall be made after due scrutiny and certification by J. R. Hospital, within one month from the date of receipt of the bill, by NEFT to the hospital by Sr. DFM-BCT.
16. The MOU is valid for One year and should be sent for renewal well in advance before the expiry date. In case of procedures to be conducted package rates as agreed to will be apply.
17. There shall be no refusal of services, once a patient is referred to by Railway for treatment.
18. The Hospital must submit the rates of all treatment procedures / investigation / facilities available with them and as charged by them.
