1. Candidates should have requisite academic qualification on the date of Interview. Those who are appearing at and/or awaiting results of final examination are not eligible. Academic and Technical Qualification must be from a recognized Institution/Board, otherwise candidature will be rejected. Candidates having higher qualification may also apply & indicate the details.
2. **Age relaxation of 5 years is applicable to SC/ST & 3 years to OBC categories against SC/ST & OBC vacancy respectively.**
3. Selection will be through the process of Walk-in Interview. After verification of Documents, only those candidates who are found eligible will be allowed to appear for Interview. All documents have to be produced in ORIGINAL at the time of Interviews along with the attested copies.
4. **The vacancies indicated may vary, depending on resignations being given by existing candidates, etc.** If any of the Senior Resident and House surgeon post remains vacant, walk in interview will be conducted on every first and third Thursday for Senior resident and 2nd and 4th Tuesday for House surgeon at same venue.
5. Please Note that any discrepancy pertaining to the documents may invite cancellation of offer of appointment as well as legal action under the relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code (IPC).
6. SC/ST candidates are required to submit their caste certificate (issued before the date of submission of their applications) issued only by the Authorized Competent Authority of the Maharashtra State Govt/Govt of India.
7. OBC candidates are required to submit their caste certificate (issued before the date of submission of their applications & but within ONE year from the date of Walk in Interview) duly mentioning about the Creamy Layer status)
8. EWS candidates are required to submit the certificate issued by the Competent authority issued within one year from the date of Walk in interview.
9. No TA /DA or Railway Pass will be given for joining the duty after engagement.

Terms and condition for Part time Dental Surgeon

1. **The selected Candidate will be engaged on contract terms for one year from the date of Engagement. The engagement of the above candidate is a stop gap arrangement and will not count as service.**
2. Engagement on Contract basis of the candidates will be subject to their being found suitable in order of merit by Selection Committee. The candidates found suitable against the requirement of vacancy in order of merit will be sent for Medical Test as per rules.
3. The decision of this office in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, selection, allotment of posts to selected candidates will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained in this

connection. Candidates who submits forged caste certificate for securing eligibility, shall be liable for rejection of his/her candidature for the particular post for which he/she has applied.

4. Contract **Part time dental Surgeon** who enter into contract with the Railway will not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract. Services rendered as full time contract will not have any right in respect of considering of their period in regular selection through *UPSC/ RRB* nor will it confer any right for regularization or absorption .Candidates while applying should indicate past service rendered, if any including the period of contract put in by them on Indian Railway.
5. **No private practice or any other employment will be permitted during the subsistence of the contract period. No Objection Certificate** If working NOC from Current employer is required
6. **The contract shall be liable to be terminated by giving 15 days notice by either side for Part time dental Surgeon without assigning any reason or if the contract Part time dental Surgeon is mentally/physically incapacitated.**
7. **The Railway Administration reserves the right to deploy the candidate anywhere on the Division/Unit depending upon the exigency of service. Refusal otherwise on the part of the candidate shall be deemed to be misconduct.**

Terms and Conditions for Senior Resident

Senior residents posts of Jagjivanram Hospital, Mumbai Central are accredited for DMER, Mumbai, Maharashtra, Government Post PG Service Bond .

(i) Post Graduate Degree recognised by MCI in the concerned Specialty,^[1]_[SEP]

(ii) Post Graduate Diploma recognised by MCI In the concerned Specialty,

(iii) Post PG Qualification for SR in Super specialty (G I Surgery & Gastroenterology & CVTS)

(iv) The candidate should complete the tenure of PG Degree/ Diploma on or before the date of interview.^[1]_[SEP]

(v) ONLY If candidates with PG Qualification are not available in a particular specialty, those without PG qualification but having at least three years experience after MBBS out of which one year of Junior Residency from a Government Hospital or MCI recognized private hospital in the concerned specialty, can be considered for a period of one year only.

- (b) **Registration:** Candidates must have a valid registration with Medical Council of India (MCI) /Maharashtra Medical Council (MMC) /State Medical Council.

Tenure of Senior Residency:

Tenure: Initial appointment will be for One Year only. This would be extendable to a total maximum period of three (03) years in the form of subsequent 2 annual extensions , subject to satisfactory work , conduct & performance.^[1]_[SEP] Termination of appointment / Resignation can be done on one month prior notice or payment of one month salary from either side.

Accommodation

Residential unfurnished sharing accommodation would be provided to Senior Residents subject to availability. No HRA will be paid if accommodation is provided and license fee, electricity and water charges will be deducted from monthly emoluments.

Leave entitlements

- Entitled to total 20 days leave in one contract year which can be availed as not more than 10 in six months period.
- Not entitled to any vacation or any other type of leave.

Medical Treatment Facility

Free OPD treatment Medical facility as available in Railway Hospital will be provided to the Senior Residents for self, spouse & children .Free Indoor Medical treatment as available in Railway Hospital will be extended to self only in emergency and acute illness situation There shall not be any provision for referral to other Private Medical Centers for treatment.

Duties and Responsibilities

Duties and responsibilities of the Senior Residents will be as fixed by the Railway administration from time to time. They will be required to perform any work as may be needed in the legitimate interest of Railway administration including National Programmes or during Railway accidents, in addition to their specialty work. **The Railway Administration reserves the right to deploy the candidate anywhere on the Division/Unit depending upon the exigency of service. Refusal otherwise on the part of the candidate shall be deemed to be misconduct.No private practice shall be permitted**

The candidates should bring all original documents along with a set of self attested photocopy of the same pertaining to age, qualification, MCI registration, work experience, caste etc. Letter of recommendation from Gaz Officer **or** satisfactory work report from previous employer is desirable. Attested Xerox copies of PAN, ADHAR Card, Caste certificate, two passport size photographs (updated and latest where ever applicable) should be brought on the date of walk in interview. 5. 08 days casual leave will be granted in a year.
6. House Surgeon will be engaged in OPD, IPD and Emergency duties and any other duty assigned by administration.
